



## **The project «70 STEPS TOWARDS EUROPEAN PEACE» was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"**

**Four (4) events have been carried out within this project:**

### **Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 103 citizens, including 25 participants from the city of Makrakomi (**GREECE**), 1 participant from the city of Varna (**BULGARIA**), 2 participants from the city of Ljubljana (**SLOVENIA**), 1 participant from the city of Livadhja (**ALBANIA**), 4 participants from the city of Athens (**GREECE**) 70 participants from Greece.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in the Cultural Centre "Athanasios and Mairy Akridas" (**Spercheiada, Greece**), from 15/02/2016 to 17/02/2016

**Short description:** The aim of the event was : The awakening of the peoples and the assertion of values such as freedom, democracy, solidarity and respect for diversity of the other - Deepening both in history and in the current European affairs and promotion of the single European identity established through universal struggle against Nazism and fascism - Contribution to the understanding of the citizens of the Union, its history and diversity.

### **Event 2**

**Participation:** The event involved 108 citizens, including 25 participants from the city of Makrakomi (**GREECE**), 3 participants from the city of Clontarf, Dublin (**IRELAND**), 3 participants from the city of Lakatamia (**CYPRUS**), 2 participants from the city of Berlin (**GERMANY**), 4 participants from the city of Athens (**GREECE**), 1 participant from the city of London (**UNITED KINGDOM**), 70 participants from Greece.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in the Cultural Centre "Athanasios and Mairy Akridas" (**Spercheiada, Greece**), from 07/04/2016 to 09/04/2016

**Short description:** The aim of the event was : The errors occurred at the time and led to the disaster - The psychological analysis of people, the desire for expansionism, for freedom and independence - Europe through its contrasts - Strengthening awareness about the common history and promotion of peace and values through dialogue and history.

### **Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 106 citizens, including 25 participants from the city of Makrakomi (**GREECE**), 1 participant from the city of Varna (**BULGARIA**), 1 participant from the city of Livadhja (**ALBANIA**), 2 participants from the city of Lille (**FRANCE**), 2 participants from the city of Budapest (**HUNGARY**), 4 participants from the city of Athens (**GREECE**), 1 participant from the city of Berlin (**GERMANY**), 70 participants from Greece.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in the Cultural Centre "Athanasios and Mairy Akridas" (**Spercheiada, Greece**), from 20/05/2016 to 22/05/2016

**Short description:** The aim of the event was : The active participation of specific population groups (women, youth) to the resistance in Greece and Europe - Understanding that art can be a national awakening in the consciousness or enslave them - How the newspapers, posters and leaflets

circulated during the Second World War in Europe - Look at today and the role of voluntary organizations promoting peace – Expansion of social participation at EU level, the understanding of citizens in EU policies, the acceptance of social and intercultural participation and volunteering at Union level.

**Short description:** The aim of the event was : Analysis about the negative side that the war has brought to Europe in the years that followed him - Signing pact to create history and intercultural network to continuous communication and cooperation - Through intercultural dialogue and exchange of views the creation of conditions of pluralism and inclusiveness, key features of the European Union - Strengthening the common European identity.
